

VCF's Mission:


To help provide dana/resources for the spread of Vipassana meditation around the globe — **by** distributing grants & loans to new & existing centers worldwide.

Some history:

- Established in 2008 with Goenkaji's blessing
- Registered as non-profit in the U.S.
 with Community Foundation status*
- Initial focus was on the "Americas" (North and South America)
- In 2020, expanded its charter to a global grantmaking focus



^{*} This registration status allows U.S. based old students to get a tax deduction for their dana.

Organizational Structure:

- Overall governance: Managed by VCF Board & Executive Committee comprised mainly of Acariyas and ATs
- Global Grantmaking: Led by Geographic Committees* & VCF Distribution Committee
- Operations: Managed by VCF Treasurer, two part-time staff, and the Finance Committee



VCF Services:

VCF offers services to support three groups:

- New Centers/Geographies
- Existing Centers/Trusts
- Old Students



New Centers/Geographies:

VCF support includes:


- Non-center courses: supporting noncenter courses in new/emerging regions*
- Legal support: supporting/funding legal needs for new trusts and centers
- New-center land purchases: providing grants to purchase new land



Existing Centers/Trusts:

VCF support includes:

- Grants for Center Construction: grants for new construction projects
- Complex Gifts: receiving crypto-currency and other complex gifts on behalf of centers
- **Investment Fund:** new service of investing dana on the behalf of centers



Old Student Support

VCF endeavors to facilitate the volition of old students in giving dana globally via:

- International Giving: providing OS simple means of donating internationally*
- Anonymous Gifts: allowing old students to make gifts anonymously to centers
- Complex & Crypto Currency Gifts: helping OS donors and centers with non-cash gifts
- **Donor Advised Funds:** allowing old students to manage their giving to various dhamma organizations



^{*} U.S. based old students are also able to get a tax write-off for their international donations

VCF ROLE/PROCESS:

Distribution of Funds:

- Old students come to VCF with the volition to support a specific center/region
- VCF mainly plays a **logistics role** to facilitate OS international giving
- VCF <u>does not</u> have surplus funds that it distributes to centers regionally*



^{*} Funds are instead distributed based on the dana and specific volition of various old students

VCF GRANT PROCESS:

For Centers that Receive a Grant*:

- Need to initially provide some background/legal information
- Sign a grant agreement
- Provide simple annual report (brief description of use of funds)



^{*} Centers are not able to apply for a grant from VCF given that VCF grants are based on OS volition

VCF CHECKS & BALANCES:

VCF strives to serve as a *neutral party* in distributing dana globally by:

- Serving the volition of old students
- Working with our geographic committee members to provide due diligence and guidance on all grantmaking
- Having all grants reviewed by our geographic committees and/or board

VCF: EXAMPLES OF RECENT GRANTS PROVIDED


Types of grants include: construction projects, legal support, land purchase & funding courses

- Argentina (Dhamma Viriya): Legal Support Grant for title transfer/center establishment
- Austria (Dhamma Mudita): Construction Grant for five trailers
- Brazil (Dhamma Santi): Construction Grant for dorms, bathrooms and server rooms
- Colombia (Dhamma Nandanavana): Land Purchase Support Grant
- Israel (Dhamma Pamoda): Course Grant to support costs related to food, electricity & water
- Mozambique (Vipassana Mozambique): Course Grant for non-center ten-day
- **Philippines** (Dhamma Phala): *Construction Grant* to renovate male and female dorms impacted by termite infestation
- Sri Lanka (Dhamma Dharani): Construction Grant for Dhamma hall & accommodations
- India (Dhamma Kota): Construction Grant for work on Dhamma hall and Pagoda
- Uganda: Course Grant for non-center ten-day
- United States (Dhamma Sela): Construction Grant for water, septic and electricity
